

FY26-27 Grant & Sponsorship Program FAQ's

Once you submit your application, you will not be able to make changes. Please review your application carefully and ensure all information is included and accurate before submitting.

1. What's new in this year's grant program?
 - a. Application window is August 1, 2026 – August 31, 2026 *(for grants only – sponsorships are still year-round, granted funding still remains)*
 - b. Existing grantees are eligible to apply before the end of their current grant year, as long as the requested funding is for a different project
 - c. Grant applications must seek awards for between \$50,000-\$300,000 only
 - d. There is one grant application – we removed any reference to “simple” and “full” grants
 - e. Our FY26-27 funding priorities are listed below. *Projects outside of these funding priority areas are not eligible for funding this grant season.*
 - Prevention and management of the following chronic conditions (all ages/groups): Alzheimer's disease and other dementia, cancer, diabetes and/or hypertensive diseases
 - Alcohol and substance use disorder prevention and treatment (all ages/groups)
 - Youth nutrition access
 - Youth mental health: anxiety, depression, and/or suicidality
 - f. Government agencies, including cities, school districts, and special districts, may apply if they are located within the Grossmont Healthcare District boundaries and the proposed project has a clear healthcare nexus.
2. Does my organization have to be located within the boundaries of the Grossmont Healthcare District?
 - a. Not necessarily. Organizations located outside the District may still be eligible if the proposed project primarily benefits residents within the Grossmont Healthcare District (Government agencies **MUST** be within GHD boundaries).
3. What financial statements are required to be submitted?
 - a. Audited Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet)
 - b. Audited Statement of Activities (Income Statement/Profit and Loss)
 - c. Audited Statement of Cash Flows
4. What if our recent fiscal year or calendar year audited financial statements are not yet available?
 - a. Submit the most recent audited financial statements available.

5. What if our organization does not have audited financial statements?
 - a. Submit your organization's most recent IRS Form 990, 990-EZ or 990-N.
 - b. Submit the most recent internally prepared Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet), Statement of Activities (Income Statement/Profit and Loss) and Statement of Cash Flows for the most recently completed fiscal or calendar year.
6. Does my All Budget Sources Form need to balance to my Project Budget Form?
 - a. It depends on your organization:
 - Yes. If your organization has one primary project and all organizational resources are dedicated to that project, the two forms should balance.
 - No. If your organization operates multiple programs, projects, or ongoing operations, the **All Budget Sources Form** should reflect your organization's total funding sources, while the **Project Budget Form** should reflect only the funding association with the proposed grant project. In this case, the two forms are not expected to balance.
7. A copy of our Statement of Information is required, but it does not state if a PDF of the website page showing our good standing is acceptable?
 - a. A PDF of the website, showing your good standing, would be acceptable.
